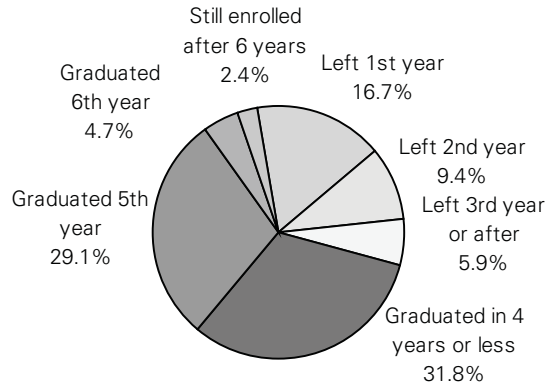

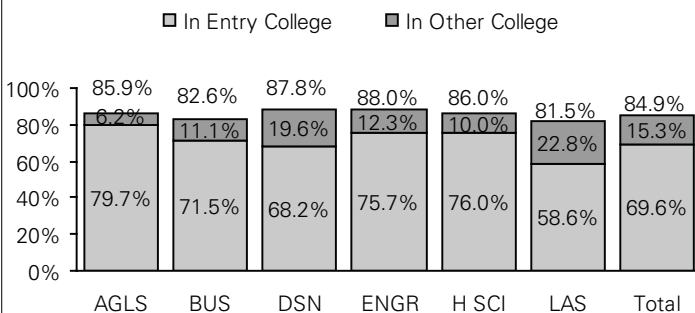

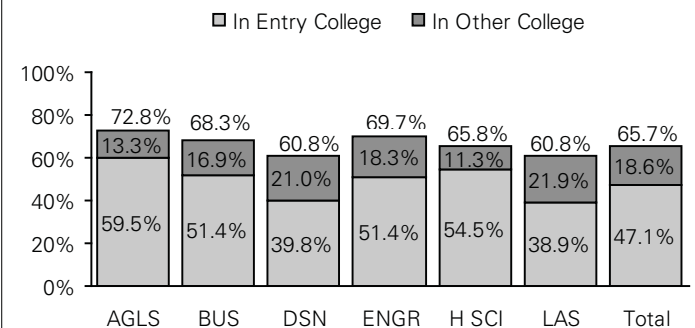
**ONE-YEAR RETENTION RATES BY ENTRY COLLEGE FOR FALL 2006 FULL-TIME FRESHMEN**
