- ¹ An undergraduate resident tuition increase for Spring 2016 was approved in September 2015 by the Board of Regents. This special tuition increase is not included in the rates listed.
Increase amount by discipline: General undergraduate, \$100; Business upper division, \$125; Engineering upper division, \$133; AST/I Tech upper division, \$133; Architecture, \$118.
- ² Art & Design-Bachelor of Arts, Design-Undeclared, Design Certificate and pre-program students pay standard tuition. Beginning in 2017-2018, other College of Design (DES) programs are assessed differential tuition.
- ³ **Engineering, AST and I Tech:**
Lower Division: Beginning in 2019-2020 Freshmen and Sophomores are assessed at different rates.
Upper Division: Tuition rates for these majors have been the same since 2014-2015; a designated rate for international students was first assessed in 2016-2017.
Graduate: Ag & Biosystems Engineering students in the College of Ag & Life Sciences have differential tuition beginning in 2018-2019. Fees are the same as all other Engineering majors.

- ⁸ Mandatory fees for 2019-2020 include: Building, \$85; Technology, \$290 (UGrad) or \$244 (Grad); Health, \$240; Health Facilities, \$16; Student Activities, \$92; Student Services, \$233; and Recreation, \$322; for a total of \$1,278 (UGrad) or \$1,232 (Grad).
- ⁹ Executive MBA students pay the same tuition and required fees rate regardless of residency.
