October payroll is used for fall semester; March payroll is used for spring semester. Colleges are organized for all years by the college structure existing on June 30, 2020.
${ }^{3}$ Beginning FY2014-2015, all data were sourced from the e-Data warehouse, which assigns SCH to departments and colleges using course splits designated by teaching departments.
Beginning Fall 2018, FTE data are sourced from Workday.
${ }^{4}$ All Colleges Totals and SCH/FTE ratios exclude Veterinary Medicine and Other SCH.
